The North Carolina Division of Appalachian Society of American Foresters opposes the sale of the Hofmann Forest. Since 1934, the Hofmann Forest has symbolized the mission and traditions of teaching, research, and extension of the School of Forestry, Department of Forestry, College of Forest Resources, and College of Natural Resources (CNR). The Hofmann Forest provides a long-term, large-scale experimental and operational working forest for demonstration, science, natural resources management, and income, including a diversity of current and future uses. The continued ownership of the Hofmann Forest demonstrates the commitment of CNR and NC State University to sustainable forest management, and NC State and its relevant forest and natural resource foundation should continue to own and manage the forest.
